TRICIA ROSE BURT (Writer/Performer/Co-Producer) is both a performance and visual artist. In the spring of 2011, she will be featured on both The Moth Radio Hour and on The Moth Mainstage. Her one-woman show, *I Will Be Good*, debuted in New Hampshire in December 2008. Her first performance piece, *Answered Prayer*, was performed in Boston in 1995. Prior to becoming an artist, Tricia developed and managed communications, marketing, and training programs for several of America's leading business institutions, including Harvard Business School Publishing and Fidelity Investments.
